

## Native Farmland Plants and their Pollinators



The National Biodiversity Data Centre will focus on #10 native farmland plants and their pollinators this year. Our native plants are vital for our farmland pollinating insect species.

## Species #1: Blackthorn Prunus spinosa, Draighean



One of the first hedgerow plants to flower, from mid February.

Blackthorn provides a valuable source of pollen and nectar for pollinators.



Pollinated flowers provide Sloes in the winter for wildlife.



Many different wild bees and hoverflies will feed on Blackthorn, including the rare Tawny mining bee.



And the Buff-tailed bumblebee.

The leaves are also a food plant for moth caterpillars.
