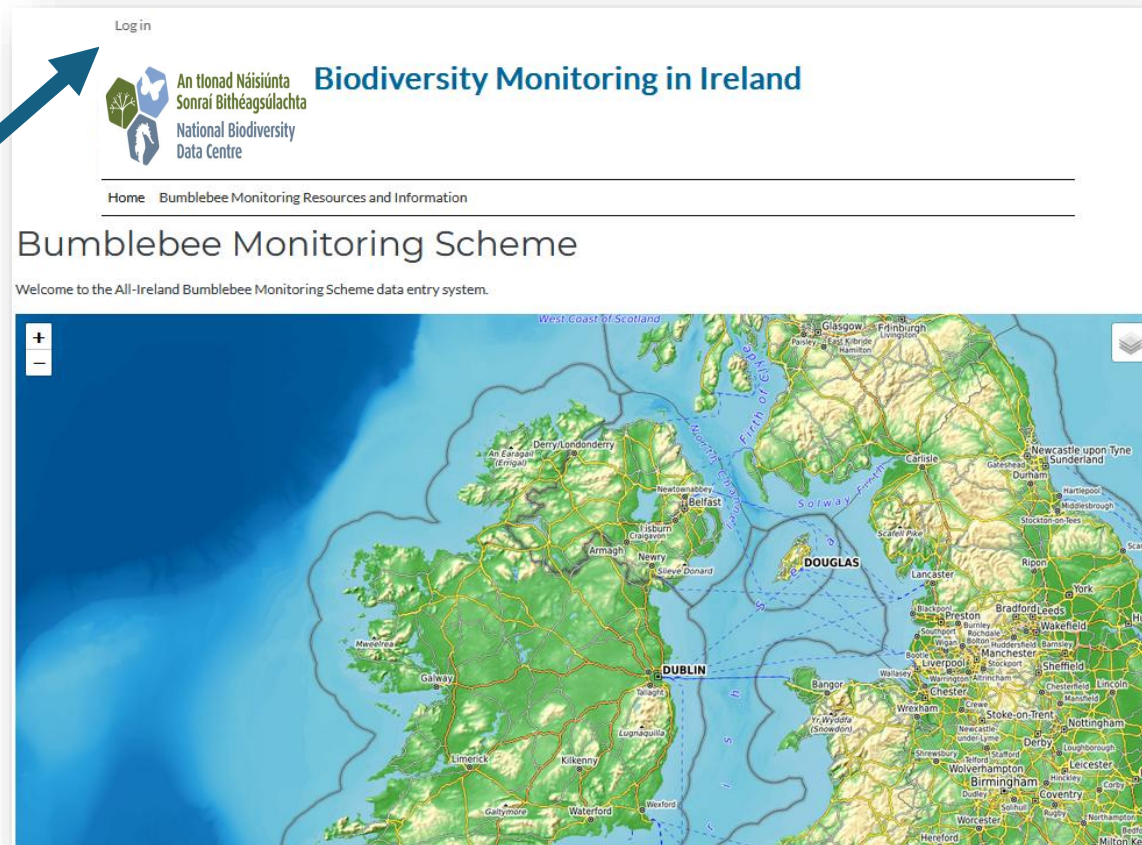



**Step 4 example:** This is an example of completed Site

I zoomed into the map to get a central grid reference for my walk.

Try to fill in as much of the form as possible. Don't worry if you're not familiar with habitats, just try to choose what you think fits best. You don't have to fill in notes on land use and management, but you can if you think it would be useful/relevant.

Once you're happy you've filled in all the site details click 'save'

## Step 5: Fill in the details of your route

When you click save it automatically brings you to the next section where you map out your route.

Select a section from the list then click on the map to draw the route and double click to finish. You can also select a section using the query tool to click on the section lines. If you make a mistake then use the Modify a feature tool to correct the line shape, or redraw the line to replace it entirely. The Delete button will remove the section completely, reducing the number of sections by one. To increase the number of sections, return to the Site Details tab, and increase the value in the No. of sections field there.

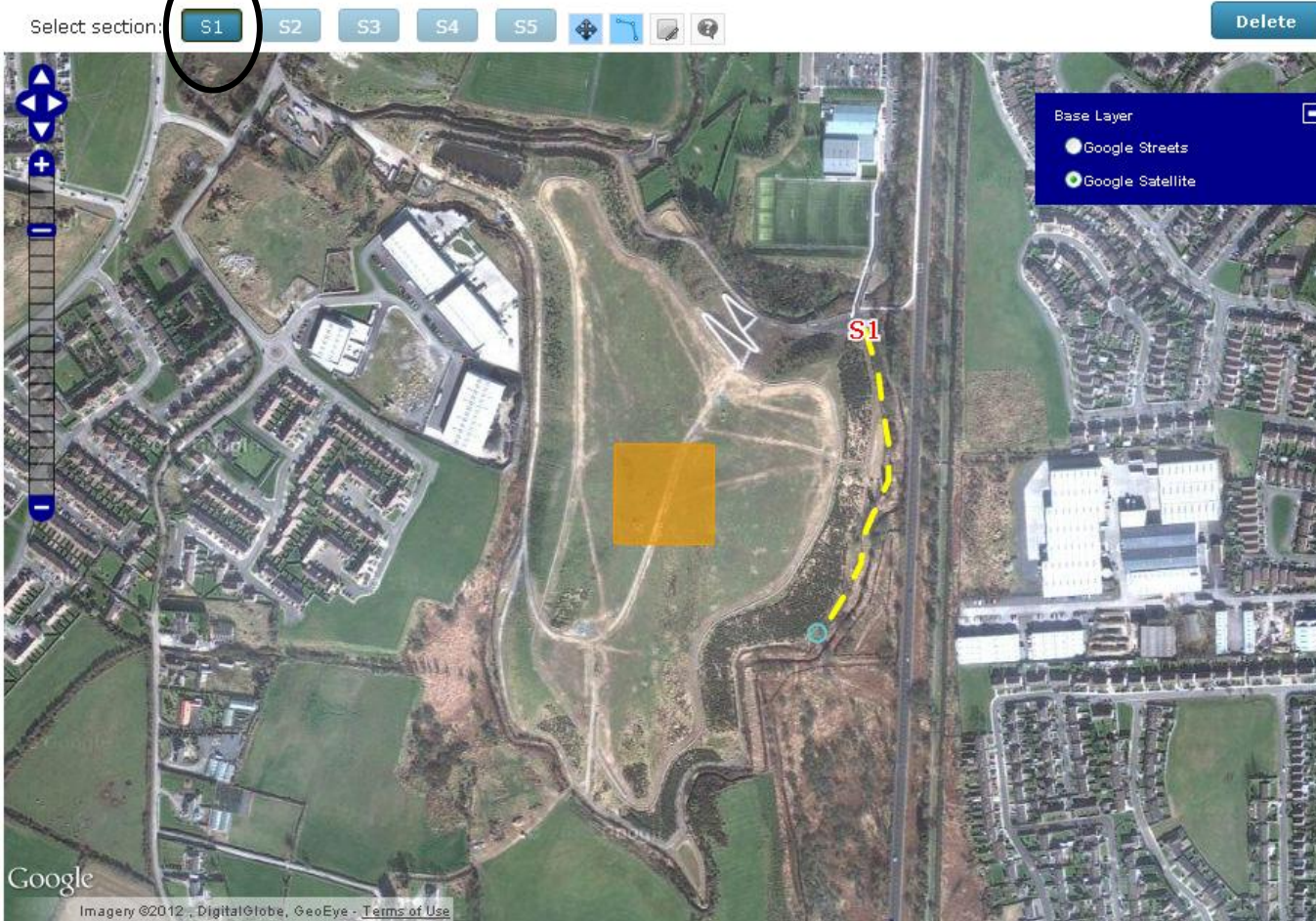

To map your route, you can either have the background map based on 'OpenStreetMap' or on 'Google Satellite'. Personally, I find it much easier to visualise my route using the satellite option.

## Step 5: Fill in the details of your route

Select a section from the list then click on the map to draw the route and double click to finish. You can also select a section using the query tool to click on the section lines. If you make a mistake then use the Modify a feature tool to correct the line shape, or redraw the line to replace it entirely. The Delete button will remove the section completely, reducing the number of sections by one. To increase the number of sections, return to the Site Details tab, and increase the value in the No. of sections field there.



Select S1 (section 1) and draw your route using the mouse. When you've reached the end of the section double click and it will be saved.

You can delete and make as many attempts as you need until you're happy.

When you've finished S1, click on S2 and do the same; then on the other sections until you have the whole route mapped.
